

Minutes of the WCOA Football Board Meeting held 23 February 2011

Attendees: Claude Burg, Greg Kaiser, Lee Mowry, Kenny Calhoun, & Hank Weil

The following items were discussed:

1. Flag Football Clinic 5 March at Plant HS. The Clinic Schedule and Field Assignments were reviewed and approved. There will be four scrimmage sites; three at Plant HS and one at Robinson HS. Food and beverages were also discussed.
2. Youth Football
 - a. Spring Youth Leagues were briefed by Hank. We will be officiating a YMCA league (started 19 Feb) and a U8FL league which begins on 11 March. There will be 31 games every Friday. The games will be played at Skyway, Progress Village, Oldsmar, and Lutz.
 - b. New contracts need to be done this year for both the TBYFL and FYFCA. An increase in game fees was discussed.
3. Tackle Football WCOA Clinics. We discussed the May and July Clinics. The decision was made to hold **one** clinic this year vice two. The clinic will be held Saturday, **7 May**, location TBD. Monte Theus' crew will lead the breakout sessions. The mile run was discussed, but a decision was not reached. **This clinic is mandatory to qualify to work playoffs.**
4. Jamborees will be played on Friday 20 May this year. There will be four teams at each of the following sites: Steinbrenner, Jefferson, Chamberlain, TBT, Bloomingdale, Strawberry Crest, and Spoto.
5. Lee Mowry will be the Rookie Training Instructor this summer. He will get with Harold Greenfield to discuss previous year's training and Mike Munger about a classroom at the Univ of Tampa.
6. Game film evaluations were discussed. Instead of giving the schools a year's worth of CDs and envelopes, we discussed giving them one before each game. We also discussed holding training sessions with veteran officials on how to evaluate game film. We need more film/crews evaluated than what we have had in the past.
7. A new evaluation form was discussed, but a decision was not made whether to use it. It will be discussed at future board meetings.
8. The 2011 Banquet was discussed. Ideas ranged from not having one, having it before the season, during the FHSAA playoffs, or in January. Various locations were also discussed. The possibility of holding a 50/50 raffle, to reduce ticket prices, at each training meeting was also discussed. No decisions were made.
