

Minutes of the 02/22/2010 WCOA Football Board Meeting at Germany Library at 6:00 PM.

Football board meeting called to order at 6:00 pm.

Attendees: Claude Burg, Thom Powers, Harold Greenfield, Dr. Greg Kaiser.
Booking Commissioners: Ken Calhoun (Varsity and JV) and Hank Weil (Youth).

Absent: Steve Clouse Jr. & Phil Crangi.

Claude Burg (WCOA VP of Football):

Claude opened the meeting with a status check on the March 6 flag clinic. Specifics were discussed. Claude wanted to know what was needed in the way of volunteers, supplies, refreshments etc. Better planning makes for a better clinic.

Requirements to work varsity flag football were discussed and approved.

These requirements being:

- 1) Registration with the state (FHSAA).
- 2) Registration with the association (WCOA).
- 3) Fingerprinting certification (the Law).
- 4) Completion of the state FHSAA Rules Video Clinic.
- 5) Passing the State Flag Football Exam with the required minimum score.

These requirements are non-negotiable. They are set by the state and local associations.

Thom Powers (WCOA President):

Reported on officials that have not paid the state, association or received fingerprinting approval.

Harold Greenfield (WCOA Board Member):

Reported facts to the board concerning flag football and the participation so far.

Number of officials that attended the meeting, took the rules clinic, registration both State & WCOA.

Doctor Greg Kaiser (WCOA Football Training Director):

Reported on the upcoming flag clinic to be held on March 6 at Plant high school.

Scrimmages are set for 6 fields. That should get all new officials on-the-field experience.

Doc presented a preliminary itinerary for the clinic. Changes can be made to accommodate needs.

Ken Calhoun (Varsity Football Booking Commissioner):

Hank stated that he had taken the matter of fingerprinting to all levels of state government with no success.

He wrote letters, talked and emailed anyone that could be affiliated with this fingerprinting problem.
