

Minutes of the 02/25/2009 WCOA Football Board Meeting at Jefferson at 6:00 PM.

Football board meeting called to order at 6:00 pm.

Ben Heugal (WCOA VP of Football):

Ben went over the flag uniform to be worn.

Ben told the membership that the fingerprinting cards were mis-printed. They had an expiration date of June 2009 and it should read June 1010. If we turn them in, the county will re-issue the cards with the correct expiration date at no charge.

Ben also mentioned that the last day to take the flag closed book exam is March 3, midnight.

Ben also said that he would be putting the flag rule book out on the web site. He had scanned the rule book and created a document of the rule book. The state provided very few rule books this year and we came up short.
