- 3) VP Report on State of the Basketball Season / Training
 - a) Visual Warning before assessing Technical Foul on coaches
 - Each game is different from the last for Coaches & Officials...
Do not give him a T or skip a warning because of what happened in the last game.
 - b) Avoid conflicts with coaches...
 - If a coach request or does not make a request and you give him a full time out that is the proper procedure. But if he makes a mistake and changes his mind and wants a 30 sec time out...it is the consensus of the membership that we will give him a 30sec t.o., but he must be made aware that the clock has already started and his time is short. This allows you to only have to count full time outs and it AVOIDS CONFLICT!
 - We have done a great job advising Coaches and our crews when a team is out of time outs. Therefore when a team calls time out and they do not have any....AGAIN, IT IS THE CONSENSUS OF MEMBERSHIP THAT WE WILL IGNORE THE REQUEST IF POSSIBLE! Some situations we are forced to issue the time out and the penalty....but when the horn and the T.O. are requested at relatively the same time...We ignore the T.O. request when they do not have a T.O. available.(Otherwise, what is the point in telling your crew that they do not have a T.O.'s left. You just call what they ask for??).

- ALL EJECTIONS HAVE TO BE REPORTED TO THE STATE AND TO THE VP IMMEDIATELY! ALL INCIDENTS AT GAMES INVOLVING OFFICIALS, FANS, COACHES NEED TO BE REPORTED TO THE VP IMMEDIATELY. IF YOU ARE UNSURE...THEN REPORT IT. ALL OFFICIALS SHOULD MAKE A REPORT TO THE VP VIA EMAIL/TEXT/PHONE.
