

Things to Remember

1. Any member can appear before the Sports Committee to discuss anything that concerns him/her. Preferably in writing.
Please coordinate this with the Vice President of Football.
2. The training director keeps football game evaluations.
If you would like to review yours, see him.
3. Do not talk to a representative of the press/media about any game.
4. Meetings are not the forums for individuals to complain about a perceived inequity. See the sports committee in private for this conversation.
5. Any official can fill out a game evaluation.
Do it in writing and be specific.
6. If you cannot make a game assignment, call the booking commissioner ASAP. Do not leave it up to someone else to do it. (no switching)
7. If you cannot make a meeting, tell a member of the sports committee. Confirm your absence and the reason for it ***in writing***.
8. Cooperate with the booking commissioner.
Don't make his job any harder than it already is.
9. If you have any suggestions to improve the organization, make them, preferably in writing.
10. A positive attitude is essential to good officiating.
Do your part to make your organization successful.
11. Do more than just accept game assignments.
Contribute in a ***positive*** manner.
A lot of time, work & effort are required for a successful football season.
