Subject: Referee's Meeting

Gentlemen,

I'd request that the group of us remain after the regular football meeting on Monday at Berkeley. I'd like to address a few items for the upcoming season and also prepare some of the items for the referee breakout session for our 7/25 clinic. Here are a few items in advance:

CREWS We'll summarize what the year will look like from a scheduling standpoint and some preliminary ideas on crews. We are trying to avoid the sit-out and will remain with 15 crews but pick up the two public high schools. We have a few changes with a few guys transferring out-of-town. We have three officials who are rated higher than guys on crews and that could cause a problem. We don't want to force anyone off of crews but we need some effort from guys who have plateaued. We can discuss Monday.

SCHEDULING VARSITY We are considering a couple of options to seek your input. 1. Draft a round or two of games and have the assignment committee complete the balance of the task for equity. 2. Build the schedule evenly for strength, TV games and if there are still a few sit-outs and after they are approved, then pull the referee name from a hat to match to a line on the schedule for the season.

ENCOURAGE OFFICIALS TO IMPROVE: We have to continue to improve each year and we want guys this year to buy new uniforms when warranted, hustle rather than walk, and just generally show a strong effort.

PREGAME TIMELINE: Did it work last year? Do we need to make some changes. How can we improve communication with band director and administrators? Perhaps we could print the pertinent details on a game card and give one to the administrator, band director and announcer? Just a thought...

EVALUATION PROCESS: We are keeping the this very successful program and are open to tweaking it. We'll solicit recommendations from you.

ADMINISTRATION: We'll cover the penalty report, hospitality report, etc.

TOPICS 7/25 Please bring your discussion items on Monday so we can list/prepare dialogue for our 7/25 clinic. This should include administrative items and also consistency in various officiating philosophies. **CONSISTENCY** is probably biggest topic from an officiating standpoint and our effort to get everyone as much on the same page as possible.
